Demand Side Management: Program participants on Residential Service Schedules 1, 2, 3, and 25, and Non-Residential Service Schedules 6, 6A, 6B, 8, 9, and 23 that are eligible to participate in the Company's Cool Keeper Program are required to participate in the Company's Cool Keeper Program in order to be eligible to receive an incentive under this schedule.~~
98. Renewable Energy Certificates: The Company retains an ownership right in any Renewable Energy Certificate associated with a participating facility equal to 0.28 MWh/ per incentivized kW per year for 20 years. The details of customer and Company responsibilities regarding the Renewable Energy Certificates are available on the Company website.
910. For Large Non-Residential systems, Customer will provide an accessible production meter base. The Company will provide a meter capable of measuring the monthly energy production of the Customer's system.
1011. All systems must meet all applicable regulations including building and electrical codes and be inspected by the local governing authority prior to receiving an incentive payment.
1112. Participating systems may be inspected to ensure program compliance.
1213. Program rules and guidelines may change periodically. The latest Program information, including forms and instructions will be available on the Program website.
1314. Unless otherwise extended by the Company after approval by the Public Service Commission of Utah, this Program is of limited duration and funding.
1415. The Company retains the right to modify or terminate the Program based on customer response or other factors. Requests for modification or termination of the Program would be made through an advice letter filing.

ELECTRIC SERVICE REGULATIONS: Service under this schedule will be in accordance with the terms of the Electric Service Agreement between the Customer and the Company. The Electric Service Regulations of the Company on file with and approved by the Public Service Commission of the State of Utah, including future applicable amendments, will be considered as forming a part of and incorporated in said Agreement.
