Dear Mr. Shortreed:

The Commission reviewed the March 1, 2016 filing by Ticaboo Utility Improvement District (Ticaboo). Ticaboo's filing addresses changes to its tariff and fee structure. The Commission also reviewed the action request response of the Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed on March 30, 2016.

The Division explains that some of the changes to the tariff language address terms of the settlement stipulation agreement reached in Docket No. 15-2508-T01, and mentions that tariff sheets ER-02-5 and ER-02-6, which are attached to the Division's response, were inadvertently excluded from Ticaboo's filing. The Division notes that the most notable change is the elimination of electric impact fees and the combination of connection and hook-up fees (i.e., the previous tariff included a \$1,500 hook-up fee and a \$500 connection fee for new service, whereas the new tariff combines these fees and increases them from \$2,000 to \$2,865 for a single connection fee for residential service). The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge Ticaboo's filing.

Based on the Commission's review of the filing and the comments received, the Commission acknowledges Ticaboo's filing. The Commission observes that the tariff has a "filed" date which is noted "TBD." The Commission directs Ticaboo to file finalized tariff sheets (including those inadvertently excluded from its March 1, 2016 filing) reflecting the correct filing date by April 30, 2016.
