In compliance with the Commission's order on April 25, 2017, in the above referenced docket, enclosed for filing are revised tariff sheets for Electric Service Schedule 94, Energy Balancing Account (EBA) Pilot Program.

As the Company evaluated the estimated effective date for compliance with the Commission's order, it was discovered that the customer credit associated with the Deer Creek post-retirement benefits in the 2016 EBA has been accounted for separately from the normal EBA account. The previously estimated June 2017 timeframe for collection of the 2016 EBA balance after netting the interim refund against the 2016 EBA was misstated because it didn't recognize the credit balance for Deer Creek post-retirement benefits. The Company's adjusted analysis projects that the end date for amortization of the 2016 EBA after netting the interim refund will be reached in April 2017 rather than June 2017 as previously projected.

Provided herein are the workpapers that show the EBA balance net of the special contract customer balance and the 2017 interim refund.

The Company respectfully requests an effective date of May 1, 2017.

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
