Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code r.746-100, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) files this Motion to Vacate Filing Date for Surrebuttal Testimony while Retaining Hearing Date and Request for Expedited Treatment (“Motion”). On January 22, 2018, a meeting was held involving Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”), the Division, the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”), and the Utah Association of Energy Users (“UAE”) (jointly the “Parties”). These are the only parties which have filed testimony in this docket.¹ As a result of this discussion, the

¹ UIEC was granted intervention, but has not filed testimony.

Parties have reached a settlement in principle. The Division is authorized to represent that the Company, the Office, UAE, and UIEC support or do not oppose this Motion.

Accordingly, the Division seeks to vacate the filing date for Surrebuttal Testimony. The Division is not requesting a change to the Hearing Date, and it is the Parties' desire to hold a hearing on the scheduled hearing date concerning a stipulation which the Parties intend to file soon with the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission").

Due to the approaching Thursday, January 25, 2018 deadline for the filing of Surrebuttal Testimony, the Division also respectfully requests that the Commission expeditiously consider this Motion.
