On January 25, 2017, Alan and Wendy Houtz (the Houtzes) filed a formal complaint against Rocky Mountain Power, a public utility. On February 24, 2017, Rocky Mountain Power answered the complaint and filed a motion to dismiss it. The presiding officer now stays the Houtzes' March 13, 2017 response deadline and issues the following scheduling order on Rocky Mountain Power's motion to dismiss:

1. The Houtzes may file a response no later than **Monday, March 13, 2017**.
2. If the Houtzes file a timely response, Rocky Mountain Power may file a final reply no later than **Thursday, March 23, 2017**.
