AMENDED NOTICE OF FILING AND COMMENT PERIOD

On February 8, 2017, PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), made the above filings (Applications), requesting the PSC approve the pole attachment agreement, dated January 18, 2017, between PacifiCorp and Crown Castle NG West, LLC; the pole attachment agreement for small cells, dated December 21, 2016, between PacifiCorp and Crown Castle NG West, LLC; and the pole attachment agreement, dated December 21, 2016, between PacifiCorp and NewPath Networks, LLC.

On February 8, 2017, the PSC issued an action request to the Division of Public Utilities (Division) to review PacifiCorp's Applications and to make recommendations by March 10, 2017. On February 9, 2017, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period allowing for

comments and reply comments on PacifiCorp's Applications on March, 13, 2017 and March 28, 2017, respectively.

On March 10, 2017, the Division filed a request to extend the due date provided in the PSC's action request by thirty days. The Division indicates it plans to meet with PacifiCorp to address several concerns regarding the Applications and requests additional time to allow the Division time to conduct a more thorough review of the Company's filings and to make a confident and complete recommendation. Based on the Division's request and other good cause presented, any interested party may now submit comments on PacifiCorp's Applications on or before **Monday, April 10, 2017**, and reply comments may be submitted no later than **Tuesday, April 25, 2017**.<sup>1</sup>
