The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed PacifiCorp's, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power ("PacifiCorp"), March 26, 2018 letter informing the PSC of its plans to file the 2017 IRP Update no later than May 1, 2018. According to PacifiCorp it has not yet received written acknowledgement orders or letters on the 2017 IRP from state commissions in Idaho, Oregon, Washington, or Wyoming. PacifiCorp states the additional time will allow it to address, or at least attempt to accommodate, state commissions' requests for additional information to be incorporated in the 2017 IRP Update, depending on the date the commissions issue their orders or letters.

The PSC acknowledges PacifiCorp's notification of its plans to file its 2017 IRP Update no later than May 1, 2018.
