The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed PacifiCorp's, dba Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), May 1, 2017 filing of its Amended 2016 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program (Report). The PSC also reviewed the June 1, 2017 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and Utah Clean Energy (UCE).

The DPU provided a comprehensive summary of the Report and recommended the PSC acknowledge the Report as complying with PSC reporting requirements for the Blue Sky Program (Program). UCE concluded the Report is complete and commented on various aspects of the Program, including Renewable Energy Certificate purchases, block prices, and community projects. UCE requested the PSC require PacifiCorp to convene interested stakeholders to clarify the purpose and scope of the community projects, potentially revise the block rate, and, if necessary, revise the Program tariff.

On June 15, 2017, PacifiCorp filed reply comments responding to UCE's concerns. Specifically, PacifiCorp noted its past efforts to gather stakeholder suggestions and feedback to improve the Program and expressed its intention to convene stakeholders in early 2018 to discuss opportunities for improvement of the Program. PacifiCorp also indicated its plans to survey Program customer satisfaction during the fourth quarter of 2017 and to obtain customer recommendations for improvements. PacifiCorp stated this survey data will inform potential improvements to the Program.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and recommendations filed by the DPU and UCE, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the PSC reporting requirements.
