Re: 17-035-20 – In the Matter of the Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of Minor Modifications to Standardized Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreements.

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### RECOMMENDATION (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed modifications to the Standardized Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreements. The Division finds these revisions to be reasonable.

### ISSUE

On April 4, 2017, the Company filed with the Commission its proposed revisions to the Standardized Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreements. In its filing, the Company requests approval for minor changes to the Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 Net Metering Interconnection and Service Agreements. The Commission issued an Action Request to the

Division requesting the Division to review and make recommendations on the Company's filing. This memorandum represents the Division's response to the Commission's Action Request.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Division reviewed the Company's filing and determined that the proposed changes are minor and consistent with discussions held with the Company prior to its filing. The proposed changes are mostly formatting changes, with the removal of some detail that is no longer pertinent or is duplicative. These changes will make the forms consistent with the Company's new software used to process applications from its website and more efficient.

There have been no changes to the forms since the 2010 proceedings, Docket No. 10-035-44 and Docket No. 10-035-45. The proposed changes include: modifying the day/date/year formatting; removing the reference to the Company's fax number for applications; and changing the format of text lines and check boxes in the Appendix of each Agreement. There appear to be no substantive changes to any of the agreements. The fees for Level 2 and Level 3 are as outlined in Rule 746-312-13.

The Division reviewed the proposed changes to the Standardized Interconnection and Net Metering Service Agreements for services up to 2 MW, and concludes that they are reasonable. Therefore, the Division recommends the Commission approve the Company's proposed changes.
