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**MOTION TO VACATE SCHEDULING CONFERENCE DATED

Pursuant to Public Service Commission Rule R746-1-301, comes now, Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”), with a motion requesting the Public Service Commission of Utah (the “Commission”) vacate the scheduling conference scheduled in the above referenced docket on August 29, 2017, and reschedule it to August 25, 2017, beginning no earlier than 9:00 a.m., but at any time available thereafter. In support of its Motion, Rocky Mountain Power states as follows:

1. On August 22, 2017, the Commission issued its Order and Notice of Scheduling Conference in this matter, among other things, ordering that a scheduling conference be held in this docket August 29, 2017.

2. Given time constraints, the Company communicated with parties in the docket to determine if they would consider holding a scheduling conference the week of August 21, 2017, instead of next week.


