INTERVENTION

ISSUED: June 22, 2017

On June 1, 2017, Kennecott Utah Copper LLC and Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company LLC jointly petitioned for leave to intervene in this docket.

Because no party has objected to the petition and good cause otherwise appears to exist, the Public Service Commission (PSC) will grant intervention. Intervention is conditioned upon the intervenors' representatives participating in this matter adhering to the Utah Standards of Professionalism and Civility adopted by the Utah Supreme Court October 16, 2003.
