Re: Review and audit of Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) Demand Side Management (DSM) Program for the 2016 calendar year.

Purpose

As part of the Division of Public Utilities (Division) ongoing mission of protecting the public interest, the Division will be performing an audit of the DSM Program for the calendar year 2016.

Background

Projects included in the DSM program include Refrigerator Recycling (canceled as of March 6th, 2016), Irrigation Load Control Program, Cool Keeper Program, Energy Star New Homes Program, Home Energy Savings Incentive Program, Home Energy Report Program, Low Income Weatherization Program, Watt smart Business (Commercial, Industrial, and Agricultural), and the Communications, Outreach and Education Program.

Issue

Annually the Division reviews various programs for compliance with state energy regulation and tariffs. Rocky Mountain Power's DSM program was chosen for review at this time. The review will entail a sampling of invoices from the DSM 193 account for the 12 months ended 2016 and a review of the program administration.
