The Public Service Commission of Utah ("PSC") reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' ("DPU") November 7, 2017 memorandum and Audit Report of the Demand-Side Management ("DSM") Program of Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), for the period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

The DPU states the intent of its audit is to review the revenues and expenses reported by PacifiCorp for the DSM Program for the year ended December 2016. The DPU concludes PacifiCorp is in general compliance with the rules and regulations set forth by the PSC. The DPU believes the program follows good business practices and is using accounting practices and controls that are adequate and practical. A Notice of Filing and Comment Period was issued on November 14, 2017; no party filed comments.

The PSC supports the DPU's efforts to audit PacifiCorp's DSM Program to ensure it is operated in compliance with the PSC's regulatory and reporting requirements, and appreciates the DPU's communication in this matter.
