### **DISCOVERY**

In the event a document filed with the PSC or produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party filing the document shall file an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) with the PSC by hand delivery and shall serve an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) on each applicable party by hand delivery if the party being served is in the same metropolitan area as the serving party, or by overnight courier if the party being served is located in a different metropolitan area from the serving party.

## **NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE**

A technical conference will be held on **Wednesday**, **August 30**, **2017**, **beginning at 9:00 a.m.** The technical conference will be held in the Fourth Floor Room 401, Heber M. Wells

The purpose of the technical conference is to allow PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power, as the energy utility to present information to PSC staff and interested parties concerning its application in this docket.

# **NOTICE OF HEARING**

The PSC will conduct a hearing in this docket on Wednesday, November 29, 2017, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in the Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah. All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify. Parties also should reserve Thursday, November 30, 2017, in the event the hearing lasts more than one day.

Individuals wishing to participate in the hearing by telephone should contact the PSC two days in advance by calling (801) 530-6716 or (toll-free) 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824) to receive a bridge number and participant passcode. Participants attending by telephone should then call the bridge number five minutes before the hearing, entering the passcode followed by the # sign to ensure participation.

#### GRANT OF EXTENSION TO EXCEED 180-DAY APPROVAL DEADLINE

Section 54-17-402 of the Utah Code provides, in relevant part:

Unless the commission determines that additional time to analyze a resource decision is warranted and is in the public interest, within

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180 days of the day on which the energy utility files a request for approval, the commission shall:

- (a) approve all or part of the resource decision;
- (b) approve all or part of the resource decision subject to conditions imposed by the commission; or
- (c) disapprove all or part of the resource decision.

Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-402(6)(a)-(c). PacifiCorp filed its application on June 30, 2017 and requested a Commission decision by December 29, 2017, which exceeds the PSC's 180-day deadline to issue its decision by approximately two days. The parties present at the scheduling conference all agreed an extension is warranted. Given the relatively short extension requested, and considering it is supported by all those present at the scheduling conference, the PSC concludes a delay is warranted and in the public interest. Therefore, we grant an extension pursuant to our statutory authority to do so. *See id*.
