MOTION FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Public Service Commission Rule R746-1-301, comes now, Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”), with a motion requesting the Public Service Commission of Utah (the “Commission”) vacate the Technical Conferences scheduled in the above referenced proceedings on August 29, 2017. The Company further requests that the Technical Conference in Docket No. 17-035-39 be rescheduled to August 30, 2017, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The Technical Conference in Docket No. 17-035-40 will be rescheduled pursuant to a future motion to the Commission. In support of its Motion, Rocky Mountain Power states as follows:

1. On July 12, 2017, Rocky Mountain Power, the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, Utah Association of Energy Users, Utah Clean Energy,

Western Resource Advocates and Ellis Hall Consultants attended the joint scheduling conference held by the Commission in these dockets. At the scheduling conference, the parties agreed to Technical Conferences in both dockets on August 30, 2017.

2. Following the scheduling conference, the Company became aware of unexpected and unavoidable scheduling conflicts of its participants in the Technical Conferences.

3. To address such scheduling conflicts, on August 11, 2017, the Company filed a motion to move the Technical Conferences from August 30, 2017 to August 29, 2017.

4. Pursuant to the Company's August 11, 2017 Motion, on August 14, 2017 the Commission approved the proposed date of the Technical Conferences of August 29, 2017.

5. Pursuant to additional, unforeseen, scheduling conflicts arising subsequent to the Commission's August 14, 2017 order, Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests that the Commission vacate the currently scheduled Technical Conferences on August 29, 2017, and reschedule the Technical Conference in Docket No. 17-035-39 to August 30, 2017, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The Technical Conference in Docket No. 17-035-40 will be rescheduled pursuant to a future motion to the Commission.

6. The Company has contacted each party in the above referenced dockets to discuss the proposed date change for the Technical Conferences and no party opposes the changes requested by this Motion.


WHEREFORE, by this Motion, Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests that the Commission vacate the currently established Technical Conference date in the above
