**STIPULATED EMERGENCY MOTION FOR ONE-DAY EXTENSION TO UAE’S
DEADLINE TO FILE SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY AND REQUEST FOR
EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

The Utah Association of Energy Users (“UAE”) and Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”) have agreed to permit UAE a one-day extension to the November 15, 2017 deadline for the filing of surrebuttal testimony in this docket as set forth in the Commission’s July 13, 2017 Scheduling Order. The extension is necessary because the Company requires additional time to respond to UAE’s Fourth and Fifth set of Data Requests, served November 6 and 7, 2017, respectively. UAE requires the Company’s response to its data requests to submit surrebuttal testimony. The Company has indicated that it will provide those responses on November 14, 2017—the same day that surrebuttal testimony in this docket is due. UAE will not have sufficient time to review the Company’s responses and timely submit surrebuttal testimony. UAE expects that it can review the Company’s responses and submit surrebuttal testimony by

November 15, 2017. The Company has agreed to grant UAE a one-day extension to the deadline to submit surrebuttal testimony. UAE has discussed the matter with both the Division of Public Utilities and the Office of Consumer Services and neither the Division nor the Office opposes the one-day extension.

Pursuant to this Stipulation between UAE and the Company, and with the agreement of the Division and the Office, UAE hereby requests that the Commission grant the one-day extension discussed above, and permit UAE to file surrebuttal testimony in this docket on November 16, 2017. UAE also requests expedited treatment of this Emergency Motion, given that the Surrebuttal deadline is today.
