ORDER GRANTING STIPULATED
ONE-DAY EXTENSION TO UAE TO
FILE SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY

ISSUED: November 16, 2017

On July 13, 2017, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) issued a Scheduling Order setting surrebuttal testimony deadlines of all parties in this docket for November 15, 2017. On November 15, 2017, the Utah Association of Energy Users (UAE) and PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), filed a Stipulated Emergency Motion for One-Day Extension (Motion) to allow UAE to file its surrebuttal testimony on November 16, 2017. UAE explains in its Motion that the requested extension relates to the timing of a discovery request response from PacifiCorp, which UAE received today, the same day as the surrebuttal testimony deadline. The Motion states that PacifiCorp has agreed to the one-day extension, and neither the Division of Public Utilities nor the Office of Consumer Services opposes the Motion.

For the reasons outlined in the Motion, and good cause appearing, we grant UAE's motion to file surrebuttal testimony on November 16, 2017 instead of November 15, 2017.
