On May 25, 2018, the Public Serivce Commission of Utah issued its Report and Order regarding PacifiCorp's dba Rocky Mountain Power ("the Company") voluntary request for approval of a resource decision to repower wind facilities ("Order"). For the eleven projects approved in the Order, the Commission directed the Company to file an accounting of each project's final costs when each of the projects are completed. In accordance with the Order, the Company hereby submits its compliance report for the projects that are completed and for which project costs are final. The Confidential report contained herein includes final project costs for the Glenrock I, Glenrock III, High Plains, McFadden Ridge, Rolling Hills, Seven Mile Hill I and Seven Mile Hill II wind facilities.

The Company's repowered Goodnoe Hills, Marengo I and Marengo II wind facilities have been placed into service, but project costs are not yet finalized as project close-out activities remain to be completed. Also, the Company's repowered Dunlap facility is scheduled to be placed into service during Sepember 2020. Once project costs for the Goodnoe Hills, Marengo I, Marengo II and Dunlap wind facilities are finalized, the Company will submit an accounting of their final project costs as required by the Order.
