Dear Ms. Saba:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed the May 25, 2021 confidential compliance filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) providing an accounting of final repowering project costs for the Marengo I, Marengo II, Dunlap, and Goodnoe Hills wind facilities. The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's May 25, 2018 Report and Order in this docket ("2018 Order").¹ The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) June 24, 2021 action request response addressing this filing.

According to DPU, the final wind repowering project costs for the Marengo I, Marengo II, and Dunlap wind facilities comply with the 2018 Order. Regarding the Goodnoe Hills project, DPU states that while the final project cost exceeded that in the 2018 Order, it is lower than the amount approved in the PSC's December 30, 2020 Order in Docket No. 20-035-04. DPU states that the final project costs for the four projects comply with the relevant PSC orders² and recommends that the PSC approve the compliance filing.

Based on the PSC's review of RMP's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges that RMP's filing complies with the filing requirement established in the 2018 Order.
