On July 7, 2017, Rulon Crosby filed a formal complaint against PacifiCorp, a public utility, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (RMP). On August 7, 2017, RMP answered the complaint and filed a motion to dismiss it. The presiding officer now stays Mr. Crosby's final reply deadline and issues the following scheduling order on RMP's motion to dismiss:

1. Mr. Crosby may file a response to the motion to dismiss no later than **Tuesday, August 22, 2017.**
2. RMP may file a final reply in support of its motion to dismiss no later than **Friday, September 1, 2017.**
