Formal Complaint of Steven Seftel against Rocky Mountain Power	<u>DOCKET NO. 17-035-46</u>
	<u>ORDER</u>

ISSUED: January 3, 2018

On August 24, 2017, Steven Seftel filed with the Public Service Commission (“PSC”) a formal complaint against Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP”). On August 24, 2017, the PSC issued a notice establishing deadlines for RMP to respond to the complaint and for Mr. Seftel to file a reply. On September 22, 2017, RMP answered the complaint and filed a motion to dismiss it. On October 10, 2017, Mr. Seftel filed a response to RMP’s answer and motion to dismiss the complaint. On November 20, 2017, the PSC issued an order denying RMP’s motion to dismiss, and established January 4, 2018 as the hearing date.

On January 2, 2018, RMP and Mr. Seftel filed a joint stipulation and motion for dismissal, stating that the parties have reached an agreement to settle the matter and no longer require adjudication of the complaint.

ORDER

Given the foregoing, the PSC dismisses the August 24, 2017 complaint of Mr. Seftel against RMP. The January 4, 2018 hearing date is vacated.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the PSC within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
