Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-4-207(1) and Utah Admin. Code R746-100-7, Salt Lake City Corporation (“Petitioner”) hereby petitions for leave to intervene in Phase I and Phase II of this docket.

Rule R746-100-7 provides intervention “for any purpose, including opposition to proposed agency action or a request for agency action filed by a party to a proceeding,” so long as the petition for intervention is made “in conformance with Section 63G-4-207.” Utah Admin. Code R746-100-7. Section 63G-4-207(2) permits intervention when “(a) the petitioner’s legal interests may be substantially affected by the formal adjudicative proceeding; and (b) the interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of the adjudicative proceedings will not be materially impaired by allowing the intervention.” Utah Code § 63G-4-207(2). In support of this petition, Petitioner states as follows:

1. Petitioner, a local governmental entity, serves the interests of a large number of citizens who are customers of Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP”). Petitioner has established community-level and municipal renewable energy and pollution reduction goals, and the Petitioner’s ability to implement these goals will be impacted by the outcomes of this docket.

2. Petitioner has existing renewable energy systems at its facilities and an interest in pursuing new renewable energy opportunities for its municipal operations. Outcomes of this docket will impact these interests, including the financial value of future onsite renewable energy investments.

3. Thus, the legal rights and interests of Petitioner may be substantially affected by this proceeding.

4. Petitioner has not fully determined the specific positions it will take or the relief it will seek. Petitioner seeks to intervene for purposes of protecting its interests as they may appear.

5. Petitioner’s request, filed prior to the deadline set forth in Scheduling Order in this matter, is timely. Thus the interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be materially impaired by allowing Petitioner to intervene.

6. Petitioner’s interests are not adequately represented by another party in this proceeding.
