Pursuant to Utah Code § 54-10a-301 and the Utah Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) March 9, 2018 Notice and Requests for Comments, the Utah Office of Consumer Services (“Office”) submits these Comments on the scheduling conflict between hearing on Phase I in this docket, scheduled for April 17, 2018, and oral arguments in the Utah Supreme Court in *Consumer Serv. v. Public Service Comm’n*, Case No. 20170364, also scheduled for April 17, 2018. Although it would be challenging, if necessary the Office will be able to accommodate both the hearing in this docket and the oral argument on the same date. However, the Office is aware that other parties to the appeal in *Consumer Serv. v. Public Service Comm’n*, Case No. 20170364 plan to file a motion seeking an extension in the oral argument date for reasons in addition to the conflict between the hearing date and the oral argument date and the Office is likely to support the motion.

In the event that any other party seeks a rescheduling of the Phase I hearing date, the Office request that this Commission order a scheduling conference as this approach will be the most efficient manner to reschedule the hearing given the numerous regulatory and related conflicts in the weeks just following the date of the potential conflict.
