Our firm, Selendy & Gay PLLC, represents Vote Solar in the above-captioned action. Pursuant to the Phase II Scheduling Order, on March 3, 2020, Vote Solar submitted for filing public copies of its affirmative testimony and related exhibits via email, enclosing a drop box folder, and additionally uploaded all confidential filings via SFTP server.

The Public Service Commission then informed Vote Solar that their policies did not allow them to access the drop box, and instead requested that the public copies of Vote Solar's testimony originally sent via email be uploaded via SFTP.

Vote Solar attempted to comply with that request and to upload copies of all non-confidential filings to the SFTP Server. However, in light of technical difficulties with the SFTP, and to provide the PSC with Vote Solar's Affirmative Testimony as efficiently as possible, Vote Solar is sending these files via encrypted DVD.
