The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the December 2, 2020 compliance filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) revising Sheet No. 137.3, Special Condition 3, to indicate that export credits will be applied against the power and energy charges on the customer's monthly bill. The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's November 25, 2020 Order Approving Tariff Revisions with Correction ("Order").

The PSC also reviewed the December 4, 2020 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU states the proposed changes to Sheet No. 137.3 correctly incorporate the revisions required by the Order and recommends the PSC approve them with an effective date of October 30, 2020.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, Sheet No. 137.3 is approved as filed, effective October 30, 2020.
