In the Matter of the Application of Rocky Mountain Power to Establish Export Credits for Customer Generated Electricity	Docket No. 17-035-61 (Phase II)  <b>MOTION TO VACATE COMMENT DEADLINES</b>
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PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP” or the “Company”) hereby submits this Motion to Vacate Comment Deadlines in the above-captioned action to the Utah Public Service Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to Utah Administrative Rules R746-1-105, R746-1-301, and Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 7. The Company has provided a copy of this Motion to the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, Utah Clean Energy, and Vote Solar, all of which have indicated that they do not oppose the motion.

On October 30, 2020, the Commission issued its final Order in the above-captioned action. The Order approved annual updates to the export credit rate (“ECR”) and invited “comments on the potential timing, procedure, and scope of annual updates” to be filed on or before February 8, 2021, with reply comments due on March 22, 2021.<sup>1</sup> After the Order was issued, several parties filed petitions for rehearing, which the Commission granted only as to “the issues of the carrying charge and capacity contribution values that should apply to avoided generation, distribution, and transmission capacity costs in the ECR.”<sup>2</sup> Rehearing is set for March 9, 2021.

The carrying charge and capacity contribution values that will be considered on rehearing are components of the ECR, and the Commission's determination on this issue could affect the parties' position on the annual ECR update. Therefore, the Company moves the Commission to vacate the comment deadlines set in the Order and to set the initial comment deadline for 30 days after an order issues on the rehearing, with reply comments due 45 days after initial comments are filed.
