
Dear Commissioners:

We represent Vote Solar in the above-captioned proceeding. The Commission's January 20, 2021 Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing provides that, consistent with Utah Code Ann. § 52-4-207, the Commission Chair may determine that holding an in-person hearing "would result in substantial risk to the health and safety of those present. If such a determination is made, the PSC will issue a notice within 30 days of the hearing providing instructions on how to participate in a virtual hearing in accordance with the statute." January 20, 2021 Order at *1-2.

The hearing in this docket is scheduled to begin on March 9—less than 30 days from now—and it is unclear whether the Commission intends to proceed in person. In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Vote Solar requests that the hearing be held virtually via the same platform and in the same format as the September 29-October 6, 2020 hearing. We have consulted with other intervenors and many join in this request.

We thank the Commission for its consideration of this letter.
