# AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER AND NOTICE OF VIRTUAL HEARING

On January 20, 2021, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing ("Scheduling Order") in this docket, providing details for an in person hearing. In our Scheduling Order we stated, "[c]onsistent with Utah Code Ann. § 52-4-207, the chair of the PSC may make a determination that holding the hearing at an anchor location would result in substantial risk to the health and safety of those present"<sup>1</sup> and that if such a determination was made, an amended notice would be issued providing instructions on how to participate in a virtual hearing in accordance with the statute.
