Dear Utah Public Service Commission,

I urge you to deny Rocky Mountain Power's appeal to recalculate rooftop solar's capacity contribution using an untested and unconventional methodology.

The resulting rooftop solar export credit proposal of 3.2 to 3.5 cents is a drastic change from the final decision made in October of 2020, and would therefore require greater scrutiny and stakeholder input than the appeal process allows.

Since installing our solar panels 2 1/2 years ago, we've sent back to the grid just under 3 times the KW hours we've pulled from the grid. Even if we'd have broken even, that's a substantial savings for Rocky Mountain Power. A fair return for local generation should be provided.
