The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the April 29, 2021 compliance filing by Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) revising Sheet No. 137.3 to provide new Exported Customer-Generated Energy Credit Rates for months June through September and for months October through May. The filing was made to effectuate the PSC's April 28, 2021 Order on Agency Rehearing ("Order").

The PSC also reviewed the April 30, 2021 comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU). DPU states the proposed changes to Sheet No. 137.3 correctly incorporate the revisions required by the Order and recommends the PSC approve them with an effective date of May 1, 2021.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, Sheet No. 137.3 is approved as filed, effective May 1, 2021.
