Hi PSC,

I am writing to leave my comments and feedback on the current net metering situation with Rocky Mountain Power in Sandy, UT.

Recently I decided to try and help make a difference to help Utah go green and installed Solar on my house in Sandy, UT. After months of deliberation, and working with multiple companies I was informed due to the net metering rates I would need to generate 115% of what I used to net-zero with Rocky Mountain. I accepted this as my part in making a difference. After many months of usage, I have found out the situation is significantly worse. My power bill between Solar and Rocky Mountain has now doubled. After speaking with Rocky Mountain Power today even their customer service representatives thought this situation to be extremely unethical. I am being charged \$0.092/kwh while only receiving credits of \$0.05/kwh. This would require me to generate 185% of my power usage just to break even with Rocky Mountain Power. How can our government and regulations allow a monopoly like Rocky Mountain Power to charge nearly double for energy than what it pays? How can we expect citizens who have to fight to pay their bills and support their families to ever be encouraged to try and make a positive difference for the world when these types of practices are allowed? I expect better from our government and from corporations so that we can leave the world in a better place than we found it. How else will future generations even have a chance?
