Will you explain why the .04 to .10 ratio was approved for net metering (for every watt I use from RMP, I must supply 2.5 watts to break even)?

I do not understand why those who purchase solar systems that are extremely expensive and that create a better situation for electricity use have to supply (export) 2.5 times the energy they use to break even. Government entities should be protecting the interests of the people. It should go back to one watt for one watt. This would be fair. Even a 50% increase (a ratio of 1 watt to 1.5 watts) would be better, but still, this is a huge percentage for any entity to be taking from its customers.
