Pursuant to Utah Code § 54-10a-301, Utah R. Civ. P. 6(b)(1)(B), Utah Admin. Code r. 746-1-105, the Office of Consumers Services (“Office”) files this Unopposed Motion for a one-day extension to respond to Monticello Wind Farm, L.L.C.’s (“MWF”) Petition for Reconsideration and Rehearing. Pursuant to Utah R. Civ. P. 6(b)(1)(B), a party can request an extension of time after the time for an act has expired if the failure to timely file was due to excusable neglect. Here, the Office of Consumer Services requests a one-day extension to respond to Monticello Wind Farm, L.L.C.’s Petition to Reconsideration and Rehearing because its failure to file on June 21, 2018 was due to excusable neglect.

The undersigned represents that upon the filing of MWF Petition for review, the undersigned mistakenly noted that the Petition was filed on June 8, 2016 and accordingly thought a response was due June 25, 2018. This mistake was compounded by discussion with an attorney representing another party in these proceedings who initially also mistakenly believed that the Response to the Petition for Reconsideration was due June 25<sup>th</sup>. Apparently, this party noticed its mistake in sufficient time to file on the correct date, June 21, 2018. However, the

undersigned was not alerted to his mistake until approximately five minutes before five p.m. on June 21, 2018, not sufficient time to file before the 5:00 deadline provided for in Utah Admin. Code r. 746-1-304(2). The undersigned has contacted the attorneys for the parties in this docket and none of them object to a one-day extension for filing the Offices Response to MWF Petition for Reconsideration. The Office hereby agrees to any extension needed by other parties caused by the instant Motion.

Accordingly, the Office respectfully request a one-day extension of the deadline for responding to MWF's Petition for Reconsideration or Rehearing pursuant to Utah Admin. Code r. 746-1-105 and Utah R. Civ. P. 6(b)(1)(B).
