The Scheduling Order, Notice of Hearing, and Notice of Scheduling Conference ("Scheduling Order") issued by the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") on March 7, 2018, reserved a hearing date of April 18, 2018, and specified that parties in this docket should provide input by April 10, 2018 on whether a hearing is necessary. In accordance with the Utah Administrative Procedures Act R746-1-301, the Company respectfully requests, given recent developments in the concurrent Wyoming Tax Reform Act, repowering and Gateway Energy Vision 2020 cases, that the Commission stay the deadline for the notice of whether a hearing is necessary until the Company has an opportunity to discuss extending the procedural schedule in this case. The Company intends to reach out to the parties in all three cases by no later than the end of this week. The Company will file a notice updating the Commission of its discussions with the parties in this case at that time.
