UNOPPOSED MOTION TO VACATE
THE DEADLINES FOR SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY AND PREHEARING LEGAL BRIEFS

Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp ("Rocky Mountain Power" or the "Company"), under Utah Admin. Code R746-1-301, moves the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") to vacate certain deadlines established in the Commission's Order Granting Motion to Amend Schedule and Notice of Hearing, issued September 21, 2018 in this docket ("Motion"). All intervenors who attended the settlement meeting held October 17, 2018 were given notice of this Motion before filing, and none oppose the Motion (the "Parties"). In support of this Motion, Rocky Mountain Power states as follows:

- 1. The Parties held additional settlement discussions October 17, 2018, which produced substantial progress toward a settlement in the docket, pending agreement on specific language.
- 2. The Parties agree that the Commission should vacate the October 24, 2018 deadline for sur-rebuttal testimony and the October 26, 2018 deadline for pre-hearing legal

briefs to allow Parties time to reach agreement on such specific language, with the expectation that a settlement agreement will be ready to be filed with the Commission on or

about October 24, 2018.

3. The Parties desire to keep the October 30, 2018 hearing date for consideration

of the settlement agreement.

4. In the unlikely event Parties are unable to reach final agreement on the

language, the Parties intend to file a motion with the Commission requesting the Commission

set a new hearing date and new deadlines for sur-rebuttal testimony and pre-hearing legal

briefs.

WHEREFORE and based upon the foregoing, Rocky Mountain Power respectfully

requests the Commission grant the Motion and vacate the deadlines for sur-rebuttal testimony

of October 24, 2018, and for pre-hearing legal briefs of October 26, 2018, leaving the

October 30, 2018 hearing date for consideration of the settlement agreement that Parties

intend to file on or about October 24, 2018.
