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ISSUED: October 22, 2018

On October 19, 2018, PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP”) filed its Unopposed Motion to Vacate the Deadlines for Sur-Rebuttal Testimony and Pre-Hearing Legal Briefs (“Motion”). On September 21, 2018, the Public Service Commission (“PSC”) issued its Order Granting Motion to Amend Schedule and Notice of Hearing (“Prior Order”), establishing a deadline of October 24, 2018 for surrebuttal testimony, a deadline of October 26, 2018 for prehearing legal briefs, and a hearing date of October 30, 2018. The Motion asks the PSC to vacate the deadlines for surrebuttal testimony and prehearing legal briefs established in the Prior Order. The Motion explains the parties are engaged in settlement discussions that are likely to result in a negotiated agreement. The Motion asks the PSC to maintain the noticed October 30, 2018 hearing date for purposes of considering the parties’ anticipated settlement agreement.

RMP represents no party opposes the Motion.

Good cause appearing, the Motion is granted. The October 24, 2018 deadline for surrebuttal testimony and the October 26, 2018 deadline for prehearing legal briefs are vacated. The PSC will conduct a hearing on October 30, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in this docket as previously noticed.
