## Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Commission acknowledge that Rocky Mountain Power's (Utility) filing dated November 30, 2018, complies with the Commission's Order Memorializing Bench Ruling Approving Electric Service Agreement (Order) in the above referenced docket.

#### Discussion

In its confidential comments dated March 12, 2018, the Office of Consumer Services recommended that PacifiCorp and US Magnesium comply with certain conditions. In its Order, the Commission ordered that "PacifiCorp and US Mag shall comply with the two OCS conditions agreed to at hearing." The Division has reviewed the filing referenced above and believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order in this matter.
