The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed US Magnesium's (US Mag) confidential annual report (Report) on its energy efficiency projects filed by PacifiCorp, dba Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), on November 30, 2018. The PSC also reviewed the December 4, 2018 action request response from the Division of Public Utilities (DPU), detailing its review of the Report.

On April 19, 2018, the PSC issued an Order Memorializing Bench Ruling Approving Electric Service Agreement (Order) in this docket. The Order required PacifiCorp and US Mag to comply with two Office of Consumer Services' conditions agreed to at the April 12, 2018 hearing in this docket. The DPU concludes the Report complies with the Order and recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report.
