RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Rocky Mountain Power's (Company) proposed update to the Tariff Index Sheet B.1.

ISSUE

On January 26, 2017 the Company filed tariff housekeeping changes with a requested effective date of January 1, 2017. On January 26, 2017 the Commission issued an Action Request for the Division to investigate the tariff change and to report its findings to the Commission as soon as possible. This memorandum represents the Division's response to the Commission's Action Request.

DISCUSSION

On November 1, 2016 in Docket 16-035-T13 the Company requested changes to the Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1 eliminating Schedule 110 – DSM New Homes Program and modifying Schedule



111 – DSM Home Energy Savings Incentive Program. The Commission approved the tariff changes on November 29, 2016 with an effective date of December 1, 2016.

In Steven McDougal's rebuttal testimony in Docket 16-035-36 filed on November 23, 2016, the Company provided modifications to the Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1 eliminating Schedule 195 – Solar Incentive Program Cost Adjustment and adding Schedule 196 - Sustainable Transportation and Energy Plan. The requested effective date for this change was January 1, 2017.

Mr. McDougal's November 23, 2016 rebuttal testimony failed to include the pending changes to the Index sheet as requested in Docket 16-035-T13 approved on November 29, 2016.

This filing is housekeeping in nature and was done to include both of the above filing changes to the Index Sheet No. B.1 for Schedules 110, 111, 195 and 196 with the effective date of January 1, 2017.

CONCLUSION

The Division has reviewed the Tariff Index Sheet change and recommends that the Commission approve the proposed changes.
