## **RECOMMENDATION (Approve)**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends the Commission approve Rocky Mountain Power's Schedule 300, as amended, dated February 23, 2017 with an effective date of March 1, 2017.

## DISCUSSION

On February 23, 2017 PacifiCorp filed a revised Schedule 300 tariff making the changes recommended in the Division's February 14, 2017 comments in this docket. Specifically, the Division had recommended that the new carrying charge rate of 4.19 percent go into effect on March 1, 2017 instead of April 1, 2017 as originally filed by Rocky Mountain Power. Beginning in 2018 the effective date is expected to become April 1.



The Division has reviewed the revised filing and concludes that it applies the Division's recommendations. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission approve Advice 17-02 as filed on February 23, 2017.
