RE: Advice No. 17-03 – Proposed Revisions to Schedule 91, Surcharge To Fund Low
Income Residential Lifeline Program

Enclosed for filing is an original and five (5) copies of updated tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.S.C.U. No. 50 of PacifiCorp, d.b.a Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”), applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. In the Company’s report on the Low Income Lifeline Program for the quarter ended December 31, 2016, submitted on January 25, 2017, in Docket No. 00-035-T07, the Company showed a balance of approximately \$1.6 million of collections in excess of credits granted for the calendar year. In order to reduce this balance to a level that better matches the amount of annual credits granted, the Company is proposing to reduce the rates on Schedule 91, Surcharge to Fund Low Income Residential Lifeline Program, that are not subject to the \$50 per month cap. Attachment A shows the proposed rates and revenue impact. The changes provide a glide path for the elimination of excess balance over a two year period. The Company will continue to monitor the account balance during this time and make additional adjustments in the future if necessary.

Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), Rocky Mountain Power (the “Company”) states that the proposed tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. The Company respectfully requests an effective date of May 1, 2017, for the proposed tariff changes.
