Re: **Reply Comments** 

In the Matter of Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Revisions to Electric

Service Schedule No. 111, Residential Energy Efficiency

Docket No. 17-035-T05

On March 16, 2017, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") issued a Notice of Filing and Comment period in the above referenced matter, allowing parties to file comments by March 31, 2017, and reply comments by April 5, 2017. The Division of Public Utilities ("DPU") and the Office of Consumer Services ("OCS") filed comments March 29, 2017. Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") provides these reply comments in response to comments filed by DPU and OCS.

The DPU and OCS both support the Company's proposed revisions to Sheet No. 111.3. The DPU supports proposed revisions to Sheet No. 111.1 contingent upon the Company filing notice with the Commission of any action taken with supporting analysis, and the OCS supported revisions to Sheet 111.1 with alternative language articulated in their comments.

After discussing DPU's and OCS' comments with them, the Company believes there was a misunderstanding with the intent of the proposed language to Sheet No. 111.1. Accordingly, the Company respectfully withdraws its proposed changes to Sheet No. 111.1, and requests the Commission only approve the proposed changes to Sheet No. 111.3, as supported by DPU and OCS. The Company will continue discussing its program tariffs with DSM Steering Committee members and file for any necessary adjustments at a later date.
