Re: *Advice No. 17-05, Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Tariff Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 111, Residential Energy Efficiency; Docket No. 17-035-T05*

Dear Mr. Lively:

The Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) reviewed the March 15, 2017 filing by PacifiCorp, dba Rocky Mountain Power (PacifiCorp), of proposed tariff revisions to Sheet Nos. 111.1 and 111.3 of Electric Service Schedule No. 111, Residential Energy Efficiency. The proposed revisions to Sheet No. 111.1 modify the Customer Participation section to allow PacifiCorp to qualify program participants at its discretion, based on criteria necessary to ensure the effective operation of the program measures and utility system. PacifiCorp also proposes adding new language to the Provisions of Service section of Sheet No. 111.3 specifying non-lighting measure incentives be capped at up to 70 percent of qualifying costs which are subject to PacifiCorp's approval. PacifiCorp states the initial non-lighting cap will be set at 50 percent. PacifiCorp requests an effective date of April 14, 2017 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and the Office of Consumer Services (OCS) filed on March 29, 2017. Both the DPU and the OCS recommend approval of the proposed changes to Sheet No. 111.3. The DPU supports PacifiCorp's proposed revisions to Sheet No. 111.1 contingent on PacifiCorp filing notice with the PSC of any action taken with supporting analysis. The OCS opposes PacifiCorp's proposed revisions to Sheet No. 111.1 but proposes alternative language addressing its concerns. On April 4, 2017, PacifiCorp filed reply comments withdrawing its proposed changes to Sheet No. 111.1, noting a misunderstanding with their intent. Accordingly, PacifiCorp requests the PSC only approve the proposed changes to Sheet No. 111.3.

Based on the PSC's review of PacifiCorp's filings and the DPU's and OCS's comments, the PSC approves the proposed modifications to Schedule No. 111 Sheet No. 111.3 effective April 14, 2017.
