In the Matter of: Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Revisions to
Schedule No. 193, Demand-Side Management (DSM) Cost Adjustment

On November 15, 2017 Rocky Mountain Power Company (Company) filed with the Public Service Commission (Commission) a proposal to reinstate the Schedule 193, Demand-Side Management Surcharge. The Commission posted a Notice of Filing and Comment Period on November 16, 2017.

The DSM Steering Committee previously discussed the original suspension of the 193 surcharge and the timeline for its reinstatement. The Company's proposal to reinstate the surcharge at this time is consistent with the discussions and agreements made in the Steering Committee.

The Office of Consumer Services (Office) recommends that the Commission approve the proposed reinstatement of the DSM Surcharge at the rate of 3.66%.
