Tariff Index - Housekeeping Filing

Enclosed for electronic filing are proposed tariff pages associated with Tariff P.S.C.U No. 50 applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405-2(D), PacifiCorp ("Company") states that the proposed tariff sheet does not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. The Company respectfully requests an effective date of January 1, 2018, for these changes.

Eleventh Revision of Sheet No. B.1

Tariff Index

The proposed change provided herein is to update the Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1 to reflect the addition of Electric Service Schedule 120, Plug-in Electric Vehicle Incentive Pilot Program and Electric Service Schedule 121, Plug-in Electric Vehicle Load Research Study Program – Temporary, which were approved by the Commission on July 18, 2017 in Docket No. 16-035-36 with an effective date of July 20, 2017.

These schedules are missing from the current Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1 because the Company made two compliance filings on July 10, 2017 – one related to Docket No. 16-035-36. as described above, and one related to Advice 17-10 (Docket No. 17-035-T09). Both filings were listed as the eighth revision of Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1. However, the Company's filing for Advice 17-10 did not contain Schedules 120 and 121 because they had not been approved by the Commission at that time. The Company subsequently filed ninth and tenth revisions of Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1 as part of Advice 17-13 and Docket No. 14-035-114, respectively, but inadvertently did not update Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1 to include Schedules 120 and 121. Therefore, this housekeeping filing is necessary to properly reflect Schedules 120 and 121 on the Tariff Index Sheet No. B.1.
