The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed PacifiCorp's, dba Rocky Mountain Power, Annual Report of the Subscriber Solar Program for the Period of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 (Report) filed on March 30, 2018. The PSC also reviewed the April 3, 2018 and May 7, 2018 comments from the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) summarizing its review of the Report.

The DPU reports the program is considered to be fully subscribed and, based on a December 31, 2017 liability account balance of (\$1,437,398) versus a forecast liability account balance of (\$2,180,000), the program is performing better than expected by \$742,602. The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Report.

Based on the PSC's review of the filing and the recommendation of the DPU, the PSC acknowledges the Report.
