Re: 18-035-T02 – Rocky Mountain Power’s Proposed Tariff Revisions to Electric Service Schedule No. 37, Avoided Cost Purchases from Qualifying Facilities

On May 31, 2018, Rocky Mountain Power (“Company”) filed with the Public Service Commission of Utah (“Commission”) its proposed tariff revisions (Advice Filing 18-02) requesting an effective date of June 8, 2018. On the same day, the Commission issued a Notice for Filing and Request for Expedited comment. In this notice the Commission asked interested parties to comment on the reasonableness of the effective date that Company requested on or before June 4, 2018.

Based on a quick overview of the Company’s filing by the Division, the Division believes that it will need about two weeks to prepare a meaningful comment regarding the Company’s filing. Therefore, assuming no party requests a scheduling conference or a hearing on the matter, the Division proposes June 20, 2018, with an effective date of June 27, 2018.
