# AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER, NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE, AND NOTICE OF HEARING

#### ISSUED: March 26, 2020

On March 25, 2020, Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) filed an Unopposed Motion to Revise the Procedural Schedule and Request for Expedited Treatment ("Motion"), requesting the Public Service Commission (PSC) amend the Scheduling Order, Notice of Technical Conference, and Notice of Hearing ("Scheduling Order") it issued on February 18, 2020.
