The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Rocky Mountain Power's (RMP) Semi-Annual Demand-Side Management (DSM) Forecast Report ("Report") filed on July 1, 2019. The PSC also reviewed the July 31, 2019 comments of the Utah Division of Public Utilities (DPU), the Office of Consumer Services (OCS), and Utah Clean Energy/Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (UCE/SWEEP), and RMP's August 15, 2019 reply comments.

The DPU and the OCS both recommend the PSC acknowledge the Report as complying with the PSC's reporting requirements. UCE/SWEEP request the PSC direct RMP to: 1) address issues related to DSM spending in 2018 and 2019; and 2) work with the DSM Steering Committee to identify a shortlist of cost-effective DSM programs that can be rapidly deployed to re-direct unspent collected DSM funds. In reply, RMP explains its 2018 DSM spending rationale and its current 2019 budget status. RMP commits to include a discussion of UCE/SWEEP's rapid DSM program deployment recommendation in a future Steering Committee meeting.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report and parties' filed comments and recommendations, the PSC acknowledges the Report as complying with the relevant reporting requirements. The PSC finds RMP's commitment to discuss rapidly deployable DSM programs addresses UCE/SWEEP's request.
