Application of Rocky Mountain Power for an Accounting Order to Defer Costs Related to Repowered Wind Plants or for Alternative Relief

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS APPLICATION

ISSUED: March 26, 2020

On December 30, 2019, Rocky Mountain Power (RMP) filed an Application for Accounting Order or Alternative Relief ("Application") with the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC). On January 9, 2020, the PSC issued a Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing. On March 4, 2020, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU), the Office of Consumer Services (OCS), and the Utah Association of Energy Users (UAE)¹ submitted testimony opposing the Application. On March 25, 2020, RMP filed a motion to dismiss the Application without prejudice ("Motion").

In the Motion, RMP states it has determined not to pursue a deferred accounting order at this time. RMP further states it notified DPU, OCS and UAE and these parties indicated they do not object to RMP's proposed withdrawal.

For good cause and based on RMP's representation that DPU, OCS, and UAE do not object to RMP's withdrawal of the Application, RMP's Motion is granted. Accordingly, the Application is dismissed without prejudice.

Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
